We have been excited to see several visitors over the last few months. Please pray with us that we would see people saved and added to the church.

It has been somewhat of a stressful summer with juggling our work in both churches, a number of vehicle problems, and also our new baby. But God has been good to us during these difficult times, and we continue to look to Him for help.

Vera is in grade two this year, and Emma began kindergarten. They both love school and are doing well. Ezra is three and a half and is all boy and he loves to play. Cara is 6 months old already and is growing so fast! Because of the US/Canada border closures, none of our family has been able to see the baby since she was born, which has been difficult for Christy. We are hoping for an opportunity for family to visit and see the baby soon.
