As soon as we got back to Newfoundland, we hit the ground running. We had our Good Friday and Easter services, an unexpected funeral a few weeks later, and things have been extremely busy. We thank the Lord that the restrictions here are almost completely gone now, and it has made things a lot easier, and visitors are more willing to come to church now.

We have had several visitors lately and are thankful for that. Please pray that the Lord will continue working in people's lives here. We are trusting that He will soften the hearts of some folks with whom we have contact, and that they will make decisions for the Lord.

Our girls finished up their first year of homeschooling. It has been a bit of a challenge, but we praise the Lord for helping us through the year. In order to homeschool our kids, they have to be registered through an existing school. The Christian school an hour away has allowed us to be registered with them. Vera and Emma were able to participate in the end of year school program last week.

We are trying to befriend some young families, and would love to have more kids at our KidsCorner program every week. Please pray for our children to make some new friends this summer at soccer, the playground, and around town.

Beginning on June 27, a BIMI CLAIM team will be here to help us make some much needed renovations in our church building. We are thankful they are able to come and assist us with the work. Please pray that we would be able to accomplish much during the week that they will be here.
